I'd like to see the black community honored and revered for teaching us what not to ever let happen again. No more slavery for anyone ever.

I would like to get together and turn Hackettstown into a model community. I would like to see us all work together to stop the tyranny taking place in society today. The general media may be corrupt, but we don't have a corrupt local radio station, WRNJ. We have a way to meet the people in our community through the radio. Maybe we can find a way to use it and educate each other to what is really happening around the world and in particular in the United States today. Once you begin to educate people and tell the truth about

what is happening, then we can come together with ideas on how best to implement changes for the good of the community.

The next thing I would do is broadcast our city council meetings and advertise these meetings so that everyone is aware they are taking place. You can't worry about the house next door that might catch on fire. That person was not happy with me or what I had posted in our soup store window. Instead of coming and talking to me, they wrote an angry anonymous message and shunned me without even knowing me or why I took the stance that I took. My message to them..... I disagree with that mentality. If we all come together, we can put out that fire and at the same time, protect all the houses that surround the burning house. It requires teamwork. We can't do it alone.

We must unite. We must wake up and join forces. We must care about one another. We must get out of our caves. That is what this country was built on. That is what will put an end to the tyranny. United we stand, divided we fall.
